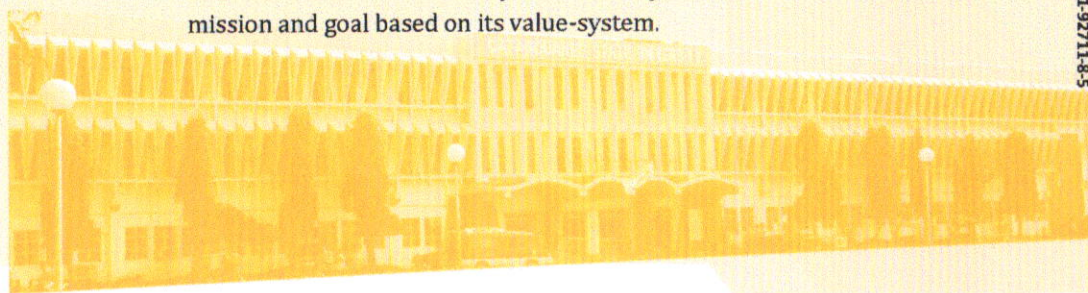
Core Values
